For accompanying persons: guided city tour, welcome reception, folkloric dinner on Thursday and gala dinner on Friday.

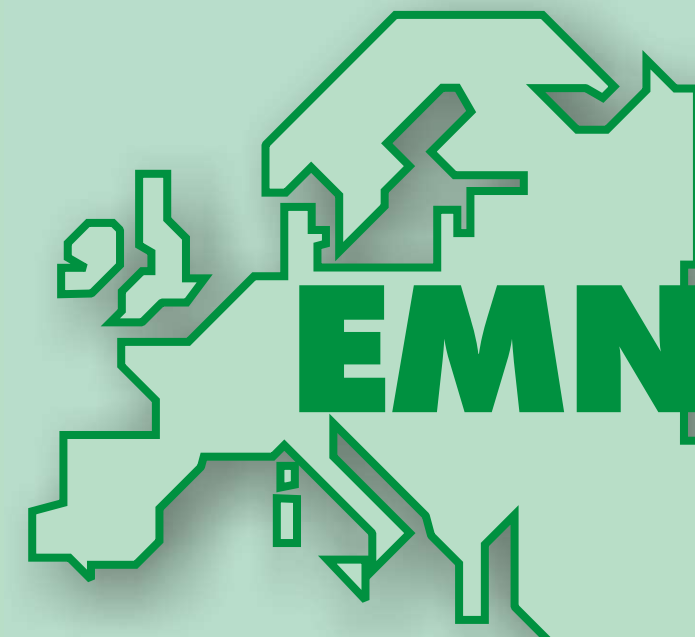
Cancellations: Cancellations must be received by May 1st, 2004 and will be subject to an administrative charge of 25%. Substitutions can be accepted at any time.
